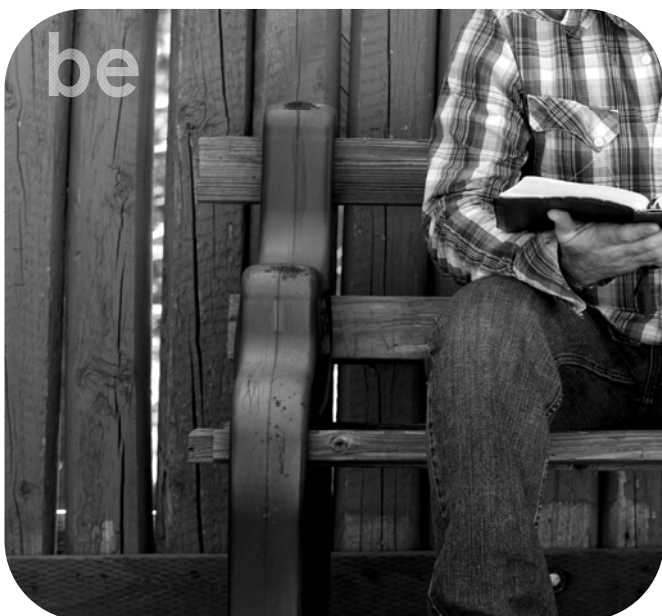

ABOUT EMMAUS CURSILLO

Cursillo is a worldwide church movement that provides a short course retreat to help Christians learn and live what is fundamental to being a Christian and discover and live out the call of God upon their life. Emmaus Cursillo is the Wellington Anglican Cursillo name for the 3 day course for young leaders aged 18-35.

The Cursillo retreat is made up of a series of talks and reflections, intended to focus the pilgrim on what is at the heart of Christian faith, life, and witness. It is conducted by a team of lay leaders and some clergy. The retreat is difficult to describe as it is designed to be experienced. However it is an opportunity to live for a short time in Christian community, to connect with God and each another. While intensive, it is not all listening, learning and work. The atmosphere is one of joy and expectancy, and talks are interspersed with discussion, prayer, worship, songs, laughter, reflection and silence.

Weekends are great, but weekends end. And then we must return to the "real world" where life goes on. The point of Cursillo is not just great weekends. It is to provide a framework for living the call of God on our lives in the world. This call can most successfully be lived out in community with other Christians who can provide encouragement, support, accountability and companionship.

Therefore following the weekend, pilgrims are encouraged to get involved in their local church communities and are given the opportunity to meet regularly with others who have experienced the Kiwi Cursillo weekend so that this sense of living out our call in community is not a one off experience, but an ongoing one that strengthens us to make a difference in the church and in our world.
